SANTA CLARA, CA -- NVIDIA (NASDAQ: NVDA) will hold its 2010 Annual Meeting of Stockholders at its headquarters in Santa Clara, Calif., on Wednesday, May 19, 2010, at 9 am Pacific Daylight Time (PDT). The meeting will take place in Building E, located at 2800 Scott Boulevard, Santa Clara, Calif.

Stockholders will need their 12-digit control number included in their notice or proxy card to access the meeting and may vote and submit questions while attending the meeting online.
